Read Acts 17:16-34 and recap the sermon.

1. What stood out to you from the sermon or passage? What convicted you? What comforted you?
2. In the sermon, we defined idolatry as anything or anyone that is put in the position of God in our lives. What are the idols that you choose before Jesus (i.e. sex, money, control, power, etc.)? How can you repent and choose Jesus over these idols this week?
3. What are the idols that you recognize in our city?
4. When it comes to the idols of our city, are you proud, indifferent, a participant, or provoked? How can you grow this week in being provoked and heartbroken over the idols around you?
5. What practical steps do you need to take to be able to speak into the specifics of what non-believers need to hear in regards to the Gospel?
6. Pray that our church would become heartbroken and provoked by the sin and idols of our city. Pray that as a church, we would meet our neighbors, coworkers, and friends where they are in order to offer them the Gospel and the good news of Jesus.
