MONTHLY MEMORY VERSE:

- Ruth 4:14

ONE BIG THING: Just like God used Boaz to redeem Ruth, God redeemed all of His people through Jesus.

REVIEW: This week in CitiKids we continued in the book of Ruth in chapter 3. We learned that to be redeemed means to be rescued from something. Naomi and Ruth come up with a plan to secure redemption for themselves by trying to convince Boaz to become their family redeemer. Boaz promises that one way or another, Ruth will be cared for. The story leaves us with Boaz telling Ruth that he is going to talk with a close relative about being the family redeemer. If he will not, Boaz promises Ruth that he will marry her and protect her. Ruth's redemption is secure. Just like God used Boaz to redeem Ruth, God redeemed all of His people through Jesus (Ephesians 1:7).
