## We Are At War

In the Scriptures, we are guided into spiritual warfare through the ancient practice of prayer. This is a chance for us to pray for protection over ourselves and others, as well as to pray prayers of advancement for the kingdom of God against the kingdom of darkness.

The following guide can act as a prayer guide to engage in spiritual warfare via prayer;

# **PRAYER GUIDE THROUGH EPHESIANS 6**

As you work through Ephesians 6:10-20, take 3-5 minutes to pray in light of the various prompts.

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.

#### Lord, help me to expect spiritual warfare in my everyday life....

13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. 14 Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace.

## Lord, help me say "no" to sin and live righteously...

16 In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one;

#### Lord, help me to resist the accusations and deceit of my ancient enemy...

17 and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, 18 praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication.

#### Lord, help me to live an undistracted, prayerful life in your presence...

To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints, 19 and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, 20 for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak. the Lord continually as a group or as individuals asking Him for healing. He delights in our persistence.

## Lord, protect those in my church family, and allow them to resist the evil one as well...
